More than sixty years ago, America's Greatest Generation fought tyranny around the world. In 2005, the World War II Memorial was dedicated in our Nation's Capital to honor the 16 million men and women who served in uniform during WWII. The Veterans who lived to see that long-awaited day in 2005 were in their eighties or older. But there are still hundreds of thousands of these Veterans who have yet to see the WWII Memorial and their numbers shrink by 800-900 each day.

Honor Flight Historic Triangle Virginia (HFHTVA) is a proud member of the Honor Flight Network with the goal of helping America's Veterans, who are willing and able of getting on a plane or bus, to visit "their" memorials. Supporting almost all of Virginia and Northeast North Carolina, HFHTVA makes two trips to Washington D.C. each year in April and October.

Veterans are accompanied by Guardians who look after their needs during the day. These Guardians are volunteers who pay their own way and have attended Guardian Training. Their mission is to assist the Veteran however they can – pushing wheelchairs, carrying belongings, or simply joining in a day full of celebration and reflection.

INFORMATION FOR VETERANS

If you are a WWII or Korean War Veteran who has not visited your memorial, or if you know a qualifying Veteran, here is everything you need to know.

The HFHTVA trip is FREE! We want to take you to see your memorial and to show our appreciation for your service. Travel, meals, and other trip related items are provided to you at no cost.

Each Veteran is accompanied by a volunteer Guardian who will assist you during the trip. Each Guardian has been screened and trained and is responsible for your care and comfort throughout the day. Additionally, there will be at least one EMT (Emergency Medical Technician) on each bus who is capable of providing emergency first aid any time the need arises.

INFORMATION FOR GUARDIANS

Guardians are responsible for the safety, care, and well-being of a Veteran throughout the day. You do everything from assisting the Veteran on stairs, push wheelchairs, assisting with meals, and help keep track of personal items, just to name a few of the duties. But most importantly, you get to spend the day with a true American hero and share the experience of this amazingly unique and enjoyable day.
